Program Overview

The MAMT is designed to provide theological education that trains pastors and leaders already serving in ministry to equip their congregations for their missional calling. The MAMT is offered exclusively through the Missional Training Center (MTC) in Phoenix, Arizona, an extension site of Covenant Seminary. It is a rigidly structured four-year program that must be completed in residence at the MTC in Phoenix.
